Platform Policy

January 2024

This policy is given with the intent to create standardized requirements for those who are tasked with leading the congregation from the platform.

Men:

- Music Department teams are required to meet the following guidelines:
 - Must wear dress slacks (no denim, casual, or work style pants) with a long-sleeved dress shirt with a tie.
 - Praise team members must wear a suit or sports coat when ministering.
- Hair must be short, conservative, and respectful. - Hair should be a person's natural color.
- No Facial hair. Sideburns must not extend below the ear.
- Tattoos must be covered when on the platform.
- Hats are never to be worn on the CLC platform.
- Dress shoes and socks are to be worn.
- All clothing is to be modest, not tight or form-fitting and should be masculine in appearance. Apparel should be conformed to the teachings/preaching of Pastor Nathaniel Haney.

Women:

- Dressy suits, dresses or skirt/blouse ensembles must be worn (no denim). All clothing must be modest.

For CLC, we define modest as:

- No tight fitting or form fitting clothing.
- Dresses and skirts must cover knees when seated.
- Sleeves are to be a minimum of 3/4 length (between elbow and the wrist)

- Necklines must be modest (within one inch of the center collarbone)
- Hair must be uncut, conservative, and respectful.
- Hair should be a person's natural color.
- No ornamental jewelry is allowed (wedding rings, brooches and watches are accepted).
- Dress shoes are to be worn (no sandals, flip flops, slippers etc.).
- Make-up is not allowed
 - This includes eye shadow, eyeliner, mascara, blush, lipstick, and colored nail polish.
 - The face is to be natural in appearance.
- All clothing is to be modest. No tight or form-fitting pieces. Should be feminine in appearance and conform to the teachings/preaching of Pastor Nathaniel Haney.

While this policy is designed to address the areas of the platform conduct, it is required that all CLC members who minister on the platform abide by the lifestyle requirements set forth.
