

Landmark Platform Dress Code

Attn:

All Choirs

Praise Team Members: Must follow all guidelines - see below.

1. Night services color code applies to all.
2. Day services NO color code – all other guidelines apply.

LADIES:

Hair up or down – neatly. No Hats of any sort. Headbands OK

Shoes - Coordinating accessory color acceptable. No boots or casual wear.

Hosiery - Must wear hosiery – Black ONLY

No fish net with large Holes. Hosiery with design acceptable – Black ONLY

Skirts, Dresses, Tops–

Solid Black ONLY- or designated color for the Night (NO Solid White)

Length: Below the knee when sitting or standing.

Neckline: No lower than 2 inches below the collarbone. No tight-fitting clothes

Sleeves - To the $\frac{3}{4}$ length or below only

No Sheer or Lace sleeves of any kind

Jewelry -No promise, purity, or birthstone rings -Wedding and Engagement Rings
ONLY Watches Acceptable

Nails - No color, that includes white - Clear Polish ONLY. No designs, glitter, or color/white tips

Make-Up - Foundation Base ONLY

No color – including blush, eyeliners, shadow, or colored lip gloss.

You may wear: Flowers, Scarves, Belts, etc. (must be designated color per night)

MEN:

Hair – clean, fresh haircut – NO facial hair

Shoes – Black ONLY

Socks – Black ONLY

Suits – Wednesday PM: Black or Grey, Thursday PM: Black or Navy Blue, Friday:

ALL BLACK - Must wear complete suit including jacket

Shirts - White ONLY – Wed, Thurs. Black ONLY – Friday (button-down dress shirts)

Neckties – Pre-determined accessory color – see guide

Jewelry – Wedding ring and watch only. NO lapel décor Nails – manicured and clean

COLOR CODE:

Wednesday, Thursday, Friday

Wednesday Night: Black and white and grey (NO SOLID WHITE)

Thursday Night: Black and Navy Blue – Gold accents ONLY

Friday Night: ALL BLACK

If you do not have accessory colors – you may wear all black any night.

If you would like to bring a solid black outfit to wear, just during choir – you may hang it in the changing rooms – see your team leader for more details.

This would allow you to change into anything you want as soon as the choir is off the platform. We understand the desire for young ladies to “dress up” for the Landmark Conference.
